The Experienced Professional Director will be engaged for a period of three years. The Overseas Director will attend SIEA Board meetings when scheduled.

The Director will assist the Board in carrying out the following responsibilities; setting strategy consistent with government policy directions, oversight of performance of the SIEA Commercialization Program and performance of the General and Commercialization Managers, preparing the corporate plan and annual budget, setting performance indicators, appointment and termination of the General Manager and Heads of Departments; and Managing communications with customers and other key stakeholders

The individual consultant shall meet the following qualification and experience requirements:

1. Applicants must possess post-graduate qualifications in Electrical Engineering and/or Management.
2. Must be a member of a recognized professional society;
3. Must have at least 10 years experience as Board Director or Senior Manager of an Electricity Utility.
