

Bracks And Schwarzenegger Sign Mou On Climate Change

Victorian Premier Steve Bracks and Californian Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger have signed a memorandum of understanding to help them work together to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and tackle climate change. “This MoU will enable Victoria and California to share expertise in climate change action and hopefully pave the way for a wider regional agreement between the Australian States and Territories and our US counterparts,” says Bracks. The agreement paves the way for the two States to work together on developing emissions trading schemes and carbon offsets, encouraging the development of clean energy technology, helping communities adapt to climate change, developing energy efficient and green building standards and conducting economic assessments of climate change and the policies associated with it.
