

Ergon Energy's \$21 million substation reaches milestone

Construction of Ergon Energy's \$21 million substation on the outskirts of Mundubbera has reached an important milestone with the installation of its new transformer. A large crane has been used to lower the 20 MVA transformer into place in the substation yard. Ergon Energy Manager Regional Services Craig Harris says the new transformer provides the substation with twice the capacity of the existing substation. "Along with the additional high voltage plant in the new substation, this will provide a more reliable power supply for almost 2,000 customers in the Mundubbera town and neighbouring areas, including Eidsvold," he says. Harris says the new transformer will not be energised for some time, but the project is on schedule for completion later this year.
