

NZ Energy Strategy calls for increase in renewable energy

The New Zealand Government has called for 90 per cent of New Zealand's electricity to be generated renewably by 2025, a significant increase from the current 73 per cent generated from hydro, geothermal and wind resources. New Zealand last generated more than 90 per cent of its electricity from renewable sources in 1981. The strategy has been detailed in a speech by New Zealand Energy Minister Nick Smith.
