REP-5 is a European Union funded programme executed by the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat undertaking renewable energy and energy efficiency activities in the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), Nauru, Niue, Palau, and the Republic of the Marshall Islands (RMI).

An immediate vacancy exists for a Renewable Energy Expert to manage the programme in FSM, Palau and RMI until January 2008. The position is based in Pohnpei, FSM with substantial travel within FSM and regionally.

The expert must have a degree in engineering and knowledge of the energy sector and renewable energy and energy efficiency in particular. He/she must be fluent in English, computer literate and have practical experience in acting in an advisory position on international development co-operation projects. He/She will report to the Programme Manger at the Programme Management Unit in Suva, Fiji
