Geotech Investigation, Design and Testing of the New Vuda and Qeleloa Power Station Sites

#### 1 Instructions to Bidders

#### 1.1 General

FEA is in the process of installing new Generators at Vuda and Qeleloa Power Station and this new site requires land refilling as stipulated in the annexed drawings. This Tender specifies the Geotechnical Engineering requirements for this new site.

#### 1.1.1 Scope of Bid

The Fiji Electricity Authority (hereinafter referred to as "the Employer"), wishes to receive bids for assisting FEA in all Geotech Engineering requirement for this new site.

#### 1.1.2 Eligible Bidders

- **1.1.2.1** This Invitation to Bid is open to bidders who have sound financial background and have previous experience in handling such turnkey projects.
- **1.1.2.2** Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility satisfactory to the Employer as the Employer shall reasonably request.
- **1.1.2.3** Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt or fraudulent practices.

#### 1.1.3 Qualification of the bidder

- **1.1.3.1** To be qualified for award of Contract, bidders shall:
- **1.1.3.2** submit a written power of attorney authorizing the signatory of the bid to commit the bidder; and
- **1.1.3.3** Submit proposals regarding work methods, scheduling and resourcing which shall be, provided in sufficient detail to confirm the bidders' capability to complete the works in accordance with the specifications and the time for completion.
- **1.1.3.4** Bidders shall also submit proposals of work methods and schedule in sufficient detail to demonstrate the adequacy of the bidders' proposals to meet the Employer's Requirements and the completion time referred to in Sub-Clause 1.1.1 above.

#### 1.1.4 Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.

#### 1.1.5 Site Visit

Site Visit is required.

#### **CONDITIONS OF TENDERING**

#### 1. TENDER DOCUMENTS

- I) One set of the Tender is provided electronically to prospective tenderers and further copies of the documents will be provided by the Authority on request in writing from Tenderers.
- ii) Tenders are to be submitted in the standard form of Tender provided and are to be accompanied by the full Tender documents with all Schedules duly completed together with all additional information and drawings required by the Specification. In addition to all information which the specification requires to be included with the Tender, Tenderers may also include any additional information which they consider necessary to explain and support their tender.
- Where a Tenderer wishes to submit a Tender which significantly deviates from this specification, he shall submit one tender which conforms with the Tender documents marked "Original Tender", together with other tenders as the Tenderer may wish to submit marked "Alternative Tender No......". Each alternative Tender shall describe clearly the manner and extent to which it departs from the conforming Tender.
- iv) A site visit is compulsory for all Bidders and is scheduled for Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> of August 2017at 10am for Qeleloa Site and 12pm for Vuda Site. For those who have visited the site you may be excused unless you need to revisit.

v) All Tenders are to remain open for acceptance for a <u>period of 90 days</u> from the date on closing of tender.

#### 2. LODGEMENT OF TENDERS

- 2.1 Tender submitted shall be complete in every respect including Tenderer's drawings and any technical literature the Tenderer may wish to submit to explain his proposal. Where a Tenderer wishes to submit a conforming tender and an alternate tender(s), the conforming tender shall be clearly marked "Original" and the non conforming, "Alternate Tender".

2.3 Any tender received after the stipulated bid closing date and time will be returned unopened to the Tenderer.

#### 3. TENDER PRICES

For the purpose of comparison, the tender prices shall be all in Fijian Currency VIP.

#### **SECTION 2.0 GENERAL**

#### 2.1 General:

FEA is in the process of installing New Generators at the new Vuda and Qeleloa Power Station sites. This Tender specifies the Geotech Investigation, Design and Testing requirement for this two sites.

#### **SECTION 3.0 TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION:**

#### 3.1 GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SCOPE OF WORKS

The Bidder is required to conduct drilling of the sites to determine the soil structure and contents for their report which is to be submitted in to FEA for the determination of the reclamation of the site area. There should be two reports, one for Vuda and one for Qeleloa.

In the reports the Bidders should detail a full Geotech Engineering report for the purpose of reclaiming or rebuilding the said sites for the use of installing portable containerized generators.

At Vuda Power Site there is a requirement for the Bidder to submit a gabion wall design to meet the 3 to 4mtr height of the reclaimed area.

The Bidder is required submit a total VIP price for the whole works where a break down for each site is indicated. The Bidder is required to calculate the number of visit required with cost rates per visit for the compact testing on each site. This should be also shown in their Pricing Schedule.

Payment shall be a lump sum one off once the works required are completed and signed by the Bidder's and Contra tor representatives.

Drawings for the two new sites are annexed in this document
