Design, Supply and Installation for 700kW Solar PV Facility and 1MW/1MWh Energy Storage System

The Tuvalu has received a Grant from the International Development Association (IDA) in various currencies towards the cost of **Design, Supply and Installation for 700kW Solar PV Facility and 1MW/1MWh Energy Storage System**. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for Design, Supply and Installation for 700kW Solar PV Facility and 1MW/1MWh Energy Storage System.

The Tuvalu Electricity Corporation now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the construction and completion of the design, engineering, planning, procurement (manufacturing/supply), construction/erection, testing, commissioning and two years of operation and maintenance support of 700kW grid-connected Solar PV facility and 1MW/1MWh Battery Energy Storage System (ESS) in Funafuti, Tuvalu (“the Facilities”). International competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Bank's Single-Stage Bidding Procedure.
