2. Regarding Item 1.0.D.8 lists IP Base license, however, on 1.0.D.7 it lists routing protocols only available on IP Services License. Does GPA need IP Services License or IP Based Licenses?

ANSWER:

IP Based Licenses are required and not IP Services Licenses.

QUESTION:

3. Regarding Item 1.0.B.9, the Cisco 3650 Series does not support this specification. Please confirm the Model Number for the Cisco Switch that supports this feature.

ANSWER:

The Cisco 3650 Series does support these features as listed on 1.0 – B.9. Ref: WS-3650-48TD-S.

QUESTION:

4. Regarding Item 1.0.D.9, the Cisco 3650 Series does not support this specification. Please confirm the Model Number for the Cisco Switch that supports this feature.

GPA does not require DNA Advantage Support. Netflow is supported on this Cisco device without DNA Advantage.
