About the Opportunity

The Forum Secretariat is now looking for a Regional Security Officer to join the team in Suva, Fiji.

Reporting to the Director Policy through the Regional Security Adviser, this role is to strengthen regional security cooperation and coordination and drive implementation of Forum regional security priorities including the expanded concept of security. Some key areas of responsibility will include (but will not be limited to):

- Production of policy advice and analysis in the area of regional security;
- Coordinating implementation of regional security priorities;
- Develop professional partnerships and relationships; and
- Representation of Forum Interests.

The Forum Secretariat is seeking an engaging and proficient individual who holds a tertiary qualification in a relevant discipline with substantial experience working on implementation and coordination of security policies and programmes at national, regional or international level. The candidate should also have an understanding of existing security/law enforcement projects, policies and programmes within the region and had demonstrated success in a representational role in inter-governmental security/law enforcement meetings and discussions.

About the Benefits

The appointment carries a competitive remuneration and benefits package including medical and life insurance. The salary will be in the range of **SDR 29,526 to SDR 44,289 per annum.** At the 1 July 2018 exchange rate this salary range was equivalent to **FJD87,046 to FJD130,569**. For non-Fijian nationals, this salary may be tax-free. To be eligible for these positions, the applicant must be a national of one of the following Forum member countries*. Applicants must be willing to travel periodically via economy class.
