Major Duties & Responsibilities

The primary function of the Water Engineer-II position is to perform engineering and project management duties - on a variety of civil, sanitary and environmental projects related to the collection and treatment of water and wastewater. The Engineer II shall design projects leading to water resources protection and infrastructure expansion. Investigate and provide solutions to water systems problems, failures and water quality issues. Update and maintain plans, permits and standard operating procedures. Provide technical support for water remediation projects, analyze scientific data and do quality-control checks. The Engineer II will also coordinate and oversee the performance of engineering tasks by subordinate staff.
