GIZ Funded License Agreement for Training Resource Material between PPA and GSES







- GSES acts as the secretariat for Sustainable Energy Industry Association of Pacific Islands (SEIAPI)
- PPA/SEIAPI in 2014 launched the PPA/SEIAPI Accreditation Program for solar designers and installers-however this has not progressed as desired because of lack of training.
- GSES on behalf of SEIAPI under a consultancy contract provided technical services for the Sustainable Energy Industry Development Program.
- Under this project 19 Unit Standards were developed that were submitted to Educational Quality and Assessment Program (EQAP-SPC) and approved for the Pacific Standards and Qualifications Register (PSQR)

GIZ/PPA/GSES License Agreement

 In 2019 GIZ purchased a one-off license agreement for Pacific Power Association for GSES training resources for 4 courses

Course - skillset	Duration of course – Days
Grid-Connected PV Systems Design & Install (GC PV)	10
Grid-Connected PV Systems with Battery Storage Design & Install (GCwB)	10
Stand Alone Power Systems (Off-grid) Design & Install (SAPS)	15
Hybrid (PV/Diesel) Systems Design and Install (HS)	5

Note: These are inline with the Pacific Unit Standards but also the relevant Units of Competency within the Australian National Training Framework





GIZ/PPA/GSES License Agreement

- Each training centre signs a one-off agreement with GSES for using the material.
- Agreements could also be signed with PPA Utility members if they want to use the material for in-house training
