Section 1. Instructions to Bidders

1. Scope of Bid Energy Fiji Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Employer"), wishes to bids for the Supply of AC Clamp Power meters.			
2. Eligible Bidders	This Invitation to Bid is open to bidders who have sound financial background and have previous experience.		
	Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility satisfactory to the Employer as the Employer shall reasonably request.		
	Bidders shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt or fraudulent.		
3. Eligible Materials, Equipment and Services	The multi meters that are to be supplied under the Contract shall have their origin from reputable manufactures with proven product performance. The bidders are required to provide evidence of the country of origin of the product.		
4. Qualification of the Bidder	To be qualified for award of Contract, bidders shall submit proposals regarding work methods, scheduling and resourcing which shall be provided in sufficient detail to confirm the bidder's capability to fulfill the contract.		
5. Cost of Bidding	The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and the Employer will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs.		
6. Submission of Bids	Bids are to be submitted to EFL via the TENDER LINK Electronic Tender Box.		
	No hard copy of the submission will be accepted.

7. Deadline for Submission of Bids	Bids must be received by the Employer at the address specified above no later than 1600 hours (Fiji Time) (Wednesday, 20th October, 2021).		
	The Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for submission of bids by issuing an addendum, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and the bidders previously subject to the original deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadlines extended.		

8. Late Bids Any bid received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed will be rejected and returned unopened to the bidder.

9. Modification and The bidder may modify or withdraw its bid after bid submission, provided that written notice of the modification or withdrawal is received by the Employer prior to the deadline for submission of bids.

No bid may be modified by the bidder after the deadline for submission of bids.

- 10. Employer's Right to Accept any Bid bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the Employer's action.
- 11. Notification of Prior to expiration of the period of bid validity prescribed by the Employer, the Employer will notify the successful bidder by email, confirmed by registered letter, that its bid has been accepted. This letter (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called the "Letter of Acceptance") shall name the sum which the Employer will pay the Contractor in consideration of the execution, and completion of the Works by the Contractor as prescribed by the Contract (hereinafter and in the Conditions of Contract called "the Contract Price").

The notification of award will constitute the formation of the Contract.

Upon the furnishing by the successful bidder of an acceptance letter, the Employer will promptly notify the other bidders that their bids have been unsuccessful.

12. Signing
Contractof
At the same time that he notifies the successful bidder that its bid has been
accepted, the Employer will send the bidder the Form of Contract Agreement
provided in the bidding documents, incorporating all agreements between the
parties.

Within 7 days of receipt of the Form of Agreement, the successful bidder shall sign the Form and return it to the Employer.

- **13. Corrupt or**The Employer requires that the Contractor observe the highest standard of**Fraudulent**ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In Pursuance of**Practices**this policy, the Employer:
 - (a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as

follows:

- (i) "corrupt practice" means behavior on the part of officials in the public or private sectors by which they improperly and unlawfully enrich themselves and/or those close to them, or induce others to do so, by misusing the position in which they are placed, and it includes the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of any such official in the procurement process or in contract execution; and
- (ii) "fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Employer, and includes collusive practice among bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Employer of the benefits of free and open competition;
- (b) EFL will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question.

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1. Technical Specifications

1.1 General Description

The bidder is to supply Energy Fiji Limited with AC clamp power meters which are designed specifically for carry out Voltage, Current and Power measurements on AC power systems.

All bidders shall cite relevant standards and submit applicable documents proving and substantiating the compliance of the products in their bids with the relevant standards.

8. Accessories

In addition to the accessories required, the bidder shall state the recommended accessories if applicable and clearly state the prices of optional accessories, independent to the items tendered for in the document.

9. Bid Prices

All non-exempt duties, taxes and other levies payable by the supplier under the Contract/Purchase Order, or for any other cause shall be included in the price and total Bid price submitted by the Bidder.

Unless otherwise specified, the unit rates and prices shall be quotes by the Bidder in the currency of the country in which the supplier is. Overseas supplier must price for DAP, Nadi Air Port, Fiji Islands. Local suppliers can price in DAP or VEP price.

10. Payment terms

The successful suppler will be paid in full only when the supply of the equipment has been fulfilled. No advance payment will be made. Should the suppler require any form of advance payment, then the supplier must provide EFL with a Bank Guaranty (BG) of the same amount as that of the advance payment. The BG shall be dated to expire post the completion of the supply. BG will be released upon completion of the supply and issuing of a Completion Certificate by EFL.

11. Period of Validity of Goods

Unless otherwise specified, bids shall remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for the receipt of Bids. A Bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by EFL as noncompliant. In exceptional circumstances, EFL shall/may solicit the Bidders' consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing.

12. Packaging and marking

The packaging of the item by the Supplier must ensure that they are capable of being delivered undamaged giving due consideration to the quantity, distance of transportation and the preferred method of handling at each location.
