The FMS (PA) will ensure the project is in accordance with the financial regulations of PPL within agreed Project budget. The FMS (PA) will be responsible for review and verify invoices against contract millstones and deliverables before processing invoices. The FM PA will prepare expenditure reports and provide continuous updates on financial related activities. Consultant will function full-time, housed under the PNG Power LTD, based in Port Moresby and may be required to travel to the provinces when required.
- 4. Duration of the Assignment: The estimated duration is approximate 4 years, but not later than 14 September 2027 when the project is scheduled to close. The position would be subject to a probationary period of six months. A performance appraisal will be undertaken every 12 months for confirmation of continuity.
