








## Change in Competitiveness of Solar and Wind Compared to Fossil Fuel 2010–2022










## Renewable Energy Share of Electricity Generation (2015–2021) (%)












#### Utility Cost Components 2021 (\$/kWh)










## Indicative Marginal Cost of RE vs Diesel Generation for Varying Levels of RE Penetration (\$/MWh)









## Relationship between Electricity Costs and Tariffs










#### What impacts end user tariffs?












#### 2021 Utility Revenues and Costs (\$/kWh)










#### Pacific utility system losses 2021 (%)
