We have registered professional engineers from multiple states, including Hawaii, and we were wondering if this was a staff qualification requirement.	Minimum requirement is for a Professional Engineer registered and active in any of the US States. Proposal should include state where they are registered, and license number.
3	We understand this project is a lump sum project. Our accounting department has asked if ASPA payments are processed by % completion or when all the work is completed?	Successful bidder may submit invoices on a monthly basis of works completed in the preceeding month.
	We work with many drillers on the islands of Hawaii but have not worked with drillers on American Samoa. If the drillers on the Hawaii islands are not able to ship drills on the island, is there a website with a list of qualified drillers on American Samoa? We also saw that ASPA received a Well Drilling Rig in 2020 and I was not sure if that was something ASPA would be interested in using as well.	There are no drillers or coring drill rigs available in the Territory. ASPA does have a drill rig and well driller, but their services are not available for use under this contract.
