- The Government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands has received financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Energy Transition Project. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB.
- 2. The **Marshals Energy Company Inc.** ("the Employer") invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction and completion of **New Switching Sub-station** ("the Facilities").
- Open competitive bidding International Advertisement will be conducted in accordance with ADB's Single Stage Two Envelope procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
- 4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - Minimum average annual construction turnover of USD 5.5 M, calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years;
 - Financial resources less financial obligations for its current contract commitments must meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of USD 1 M; and
 - Participation in at least one contract that has been successfully or substantially completed
 within the last five (5) years and that is similar to the proposed works, where the value of the
 Bidder's participation exceeds USD 5 M. The similarity of the Bidder's participation shall be
 based on the physical size, nature of works, complexity, methods, standards, specifications,
 technology or other characteristics as described in Section 6 of the Invitation Documents.
